**Please find below amendments to the Sporting Regulations published on 03rd May 2025.
Kindly note that only the following details have changed and all other information in the
Sporting Regulations published on 03rd May 2025 remain unchanged.
Failure to read and or understand the regulations will not be tolerated as an excuse.**

- 01) The Minimum Number of Entries to Schedule an event and the Minimum number of starters required for an event will be 3.
- 02) The Yamaha KT 100, 120kg class and the Iame X30 Cadet class Practice, Qualifying, Race 1 and Race 2 will be conducted concurrently. Grid Positions for the races will be as per the qualifying order.
- 03) The Yamaha KT100, 120KG class and Iame X30 class races will be 8 laps each. Duration for Practice and Qualifying will remain unchanged.
- 04) The following flag will be introduced for all classes of the Yamaha KT100 and X30 Events starting from Qualifying , Race 1 and Race 2.

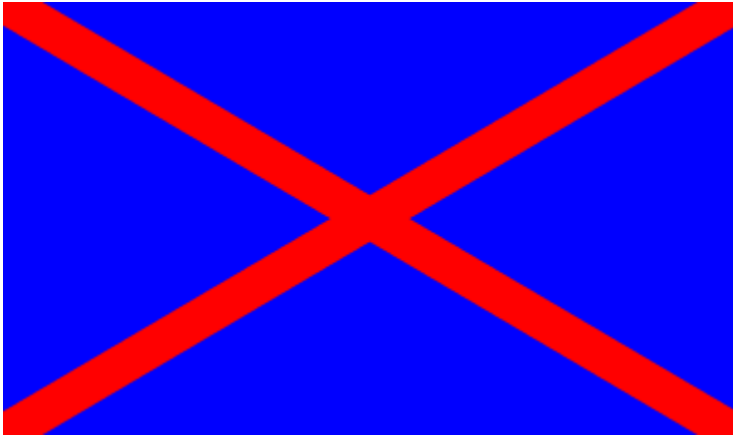
05) The Flag

DESCRIPTION – STOP FOR OVERLAPPED COMPETITOR

Apart from the blue flag, which is used during qualifying and Races, this flag will be introduced with immediate effect, Starting from Round one of the Championship 2025.

Any Driver/s, who are deemed to be too slow and in turn can create a dangerous situation for other drivers. The Flag will be deployed at the discretion of Race Director and the Stewards of the Meet.

A Demo will be carried out during the drivers briefing before the event.



HOW, WHEN AND WHERE THE FLAG WILL BE DISPLAYED.

The flag will be shown/ Displayed along with the competition numbers at the start line.

It is the responsibility of the competitor to know/ remember their respective competition numbers.

Once the Flag and the competitor number is displayed at the start/ finish line, The Respective competitor will have to report to the pits within ONE lap.

Failure to adhere to this flag will result in the disqualification from the competition (Qualifying or Race)

Only for Round 1 (3rd May 2025), the Flag ONLY will be displayed at two other corners to indicate to the drivers that A “STOP FOR OVERLAPPED COMPETITOR” is in effect. The competitors need to figure out as to which competitor the flag is meant for.
